Aloha Residents and Owners at Mahanalua Nui, Makila and Pu`unoa:

Subject: Makila/Launiupoko Community Greenway/Trail System

We are pleased to announce the opening of the first leg of the **Launiupoko Stream Trail**. This recently constructed segment provides a connection from Wailau Street to the Launiupoko Reservoir. West Maui Land Company improved this trail segment to re-establish pedestrian access to the Launiupoko Reservoir which had previously been provided by a gravel access road/easement. The newly improved trail is one component of the mauka/makai Launiupoko Archaeological Streambed Park. It is envisioned that members of the community will help with completion of the remaining sections of this corridor. (More notice on the volunteer community trail building program will be forthcoming.)

The expansion of the Greenway and Trail System is part of our ongoing community development program and a key component of Makila Land Company's long range master planning efforts.

Makila Nui = more new trails. With the recent completion of the Makila Nui (Mahanalua Nui Phase V) subdivision, additional trail easements have been established. Actual trail construction and signage will be completed soon. The Makila Nui trails offer scenic routes to the top of Puu Mahanalua Nui and Puu Hipa. When completed, these trails will provide opportunities to explore native Hawaiian plant communities in a unique geological setting. These trails traverse sensitive ecological areas and for the most part are within privately owned parcels, thus, we strongly emphasize the need to stay on the designated trails. We all stand to benefit by respecting each other, the land, and natural resources we expect to enjoy for generations to come.

Master Plan. The enclosed map is the current version Greenway and Trail System master plan. A copy of the map is also available at the West Maui Land website which can be found at www.westmauiland.com. The map illustrates existing as well as planned trails. The future routes will be developed as part of the long range master plan for Makila Land Company properties. The goal is to have an integrated greenway and trail system, linking residential areas with mauka and makai resources as well as neighboring communities. Some of the trails will also serve to provide access for fire prevention measures.

Important – Caution! The routes marked as future trails are planned but have yet to be improved, we will notify you when they become open for use. **Also, please use caution, some of the trails involve difficult terrain and are for experienced hikers only.** Please also note that only a portion of the trails or greenways will allow for equestrian or bicycle use.

As of this time there are no trails which traverse Kaua`ula Stream, please do not venture into this area and stay on the Launiupoko side of Kaua`ula Stream.





What can you do to help? Makila Land Company and West Maui Land Company will be participating in the implementation of the trail and greenway system, however, ultimately it will be the responsibility of the community, through the various homeowner associations to maintain and improve the network. We are hoping that the community will play a significant role in constructing some of the trails. Ideally the system will be “By the Community, For the Community”.
